# RAC Member Priorities Tracker Vehicle Safety

In July 2022, 334 of our members<sup>1</sup> took part in a survey telling us about their motor vehicles, and what they believe would be some of the most effective ways to get more people driving newer, and generally safer, vehicles<sup>2</sup>.

## Only 1 in 3

members correctly believed that a 2014 vehicle with a five star ANCAP rating is less safe than a 2020 vehicle with a five star ANCAP rating<sup>5</sup>

<sup>1</sup> 244 respondents were from the Perth and Peel region and 90 from regional WA. The survey was restricted to members who have a driver's licence and where there is at least one motor vehicle in their household. Age, gender, and location sampling quotas were applied, and data has been post-weighted to be representative of RACs membership (which is broadly consistent with the WA population profile) - the margin of error at the total sample level is +/-5.36 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

<sup>2</sup> This is the third vehicle generated data survey as part of this tracker. 468 members completed the first survey in June 2020 and 406 members completed the second survey in July 2021. Differences with previous years are only highlighted where notable.

- <sup>3</sup> Australasian New Car Assessment Program (ANCAP) star ratings indicate the level of safety a vehicle provides for occupants and pedestrians in the event of a crash, as well as its ability, through technology, to avoid or minimise the effects of a crash.
- 4 Used Car Safety Ratings (UCSRs) help to identify safer second-hand cars. UCSRs are based on statistics collected from police-reported car crashes in Australia and New Zealand where someone was killed or seriously injured.
- <sup>5</sup> 34% believed the two vehicles are just as safe as each other, 4% believed the 2014 vehicle is safer and 29% were unsure. Annual increases to ANCAP safety rating criteria for all star rating levels have been in place since 2011.
- <sup>6</sup> Results are members who said it is likely or very likely.
